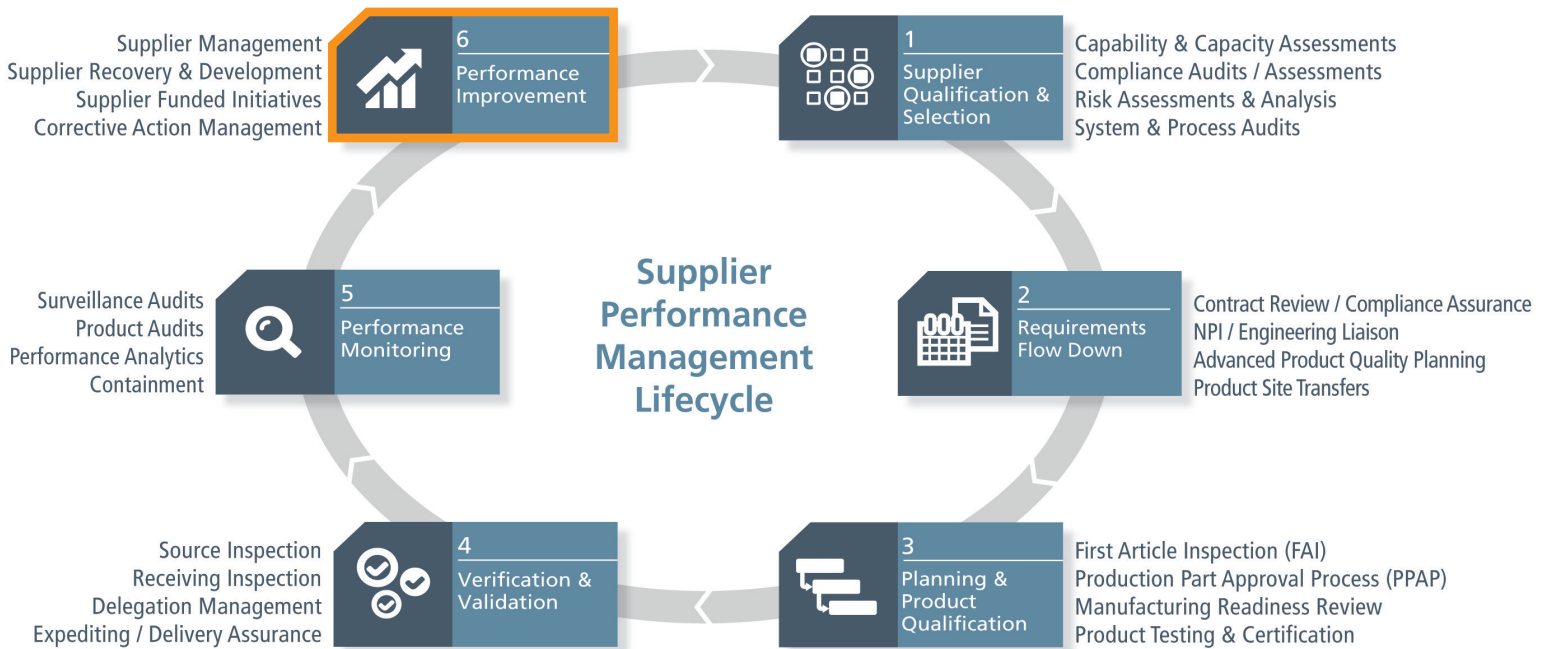




SERVICE PRODUCT BRIEF SUPPLIER FUNDED INITIATIVES

3. Supplier Recovery and Development

- Consulting level support to assess, plan, and execute on improvement initiatives at supplier cost

4. Advanced Product Quality Planning

- Training and Consulting to assess, plan, and implement APQP at supplier cost
